The Semester Program is a 13-week multi-level, full-time, comprehensive English language program of study. Levels 5 and 6 of the Semester Program focus on advanced and academic English, and prepare students for transition into the ACC.

Level 5: Advanced English Communication

Advance your English communication abilities across all skill areas with targeted classes in Applied Grammar, Reading and Writing, and Speaking and Listening.

Level 6: Academic Preparation

Learn the written and oral skills necessary for success in the English language post-secondary classroom. Comprehensive classes in Academic Grammar and Composition, Academic Reading and Vocabulary, and Academic Speaking and Listening.

- TOEFL iBT score of 55 overall, 18 in writing
- CAEL score of 50 overall, 50 in writing

Academic Mastery: University Preparation

The Academic Communication Certificate (ACC) prepares English learners to enter UCalgary degree programs. Students learn essential skills for the academic setting, acquire critical knowledge for a successful transition to Canadian university culture, meet English language proficiency admission requirements, and gain transfer credit toward a UCalgary undergraduate program.



Admission Requirements

Students must fulfill one of the following minimum requirements:

- UCalgary ELP Semester Program Level 6, Minimum B+
- IELTS Academic score of 6.0 overall, minimum 6.0 in Writing, 5.5 in any other skill area
- Duolingo English test score of 110 overall, 100 in production
- TOEFL iBT score of 70 overall, minimum of 20 in Writing
- CAEL score of 60 overall, minimum of 60 in Writing

Courses

Academic Writing & Composition

Week 1 - 6 | 58 hours

Focus on writing effective academic paragraphs and essays while mastering essential sentence skills and reading critically.

Research Writing & Form

Week 8 - 13 | 58 hours

Focus on the process of writing research papers and critical responses while mastering critical reading and thinking. Students will attain advanced skills in comprehension, analysis, interpretation and citation.

Critical Listening & Notetaking

Week 1 - 6 | 52 hours

Prepare to transition to an English-speaking university setting with the skills to engage in critical academic listening across content areas.

Oral Communication & Presentation Skills

Week 8 - 13 | 52 hours

Develop essential skills that will help English learners defend ideas in academic settings, present coherent concepts, speak thoughtfully in discussions and contribute to group projects.

Academic Success Tutorials

Week 1 - 13 | 20 hours

Twelve seminars designed to facilitate success in the Canadian university degree (credit) environment. Topics include academic integrity, critical thinking, health and wellness, learning styles, study strategies, time management, understanding learning objectives and university customs and policies.

Undergraduate Degree Transfer Credit

Students successfully completing the ACC will be eligible for 2 courses (6 units) of transfer credit toward an undergraduate degree program.

ACC to Open Studies to UCalgary Undergraduate Degree Programs

UCalgary **Open Studies** allows eligible students to take University degree-credit courses before being admitted into a degree program. Students who have completed the ACC before the fall or winter terms, may take up to four Open Studies courses (subject to availability) which may be applied towards their degrees prior to starting their undergraduate degree programs in the fall.


Pathway to UCalgary Degree Programs

Successful completion of the ACC meets the English language proficiency requirement for admission to applicable UCalgary **undergraduate** and **graduate** degree programs.* Students who start our Semester Program at level 5 or 6 may be admitted to the ACC and to degree programs conditionally if other academic requirements are met.



Sample Timelines for Undergraduate Program Admission

Students can start the Semester Program or ACC in any term that allows them to complete the ACC before the fall term.



Application Process

- 1 Apply to the English
 Language Program (ELP)
- 2 Receive invitation letter
- Apply for undergraduate program
- Receive undergraduate conditional letter of admission
- 5 Register in the ELP
- 6 Receive ELP letter of admission

- * Minimum ACC grades vary by graduate program. Please contact the graduate program you are applying to for specific requirements.
- ** Students who receive B+ or higher move to the next level.

A \$200 non-refundable application fee is required for admission into the English Language Program. This is a one-time fee.

Program information

Study Permits and Visas

Most international students require an entrance document — either a visa, an Electronic Travel Authorization (eTA), or a study permit to enter and study in Canada. Check with your nearest Canadian Embassy or Consulate for more information on applying for entrance documents and study permits. canada.ca/en/immigration-refugees-citizenship/services/study-canada.html

The Government of Canada requires that all new study permit applicants submit a Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL) from the province in which they intend to study. To learn more about PAL eligibility and policies in the English Language Program, please visit esl.ucalgary. ca/registration/policies

English Language Program Deadlines

Application must be received 4 months before the start date of the course. Full payment is required at time of registration.

Two weeks after the course begins, students not present and not in contact with the office will be withdrawn in accordance with the refund policy. Please inform the office if you cannot start the course on time.

Conditional Admission

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS

The condition of admission for undergraduate programs will be met once a student successfully completes EAP 220, 225, 230, 235 with a minimum grade of B+ and EAP 249 with a CR by August 1 in the year they received conditional admission for. Nursing and Education do not accept the Academic Communication Certificate. Where programs have additional requirements, conditional admission is only valid for the year of application.

GRADUATE PROGRAMS

The condition of admission for graduate programs will be met once a student successfully completes EAP 220, 225, 230, 235 with a minimum grade of B+ and EAP 249 with a CR by August 1, or as designated by the department. Some graduate programs require a minimum grade of A- in some ACC courses or do not accept the Academic Communication Certificate. Please contact the graduate program directly to confirm admission requirements at future.grad@ucalgary.ca.

Emergency Health Insurance

Emergency health insurance is provided for international students under 65 from the Saturday before the English course start date to the Saturday after the English course end date. All fees must be paid in full for insurance to be processed and valid. Additional insurance is available between courses at an additional cost.



Transfer Credit

Undergraduate transfer credit includes a 3 unit academic writing course and a 3 unit junior English comprehension course.

English Language Program Refund Policy

All withdrawals must be made in writing. All refunds will be made via the original payment method. Please note that program application fees and homestay placement fees are non-refundable under any circumstances.

TUITION REFUNDS AND TRANSFERS

Tuition refund eligibility is relative to the course/program start date.

REFUNDS AND TRANSFERS RELATED TO VISA/PERMIT STATUS

If you submitted an application for entry to Canada at least 3 months prior to your program start date and the Government of Canada does not provide you with the required visa/permit to enter Canada, your course tuition fees will be refunded/transferred as follows.

WITHDRAWAL DATE	REFUND/TRANSFER
15 or more days before	95% of tuition
2 – 14 days before	50% of tuition
Less than 24 hours before	No refunds/transfers

Refunds/transfers related to entry status require supporting documents from the Government of Canada Immigration and Citizenship:

- 1. A copy of the visa/permit refusal letter
- 2. A copy of the visa/permit Application Status webpage indicating the application is still in progress and date of application.
