



## Alberta Indigenous Mentorship in Health Innovation (AIM-HI) Network and the Population, Public and Indigenous Health Strategic Clinical Network (PPIHSCN™)

### First Nations, Métis and Inuit Graduate Student Experiential Internship Opportunity

#### Project Background

The AIM-HI Network and the Population, Public and Indigenous Health Strategic Clinical Network (PPIH-SCN™) have collaborated with the goal of supporting Indigenous Health Research Initiatives in Alberta, which includes increasing the number of Indigenous Researchers. Through this collaboration, salary funding will be provided to a First Nations, Métis and Inuit (FNMI) graduate student or post-doctoral fellow who will support the **evaluation** of the *Patient and Community Engagement Research (PaCER) Internship Program - Indigenous Cohort*.

The successful candidate will work with support and guidance from the PPIH SCN™ Scientific Office to further develop an evaluation design and plan to meet the intended outcomes for the evaluation. The graduate student will have experience in Indigenous engagement and in applying a blend of Indigenous and Western research methods and evaluation approaches. Data collection will occur through surveys and interviews with the following stakeholders (approximately 43 stakeholders).

#### Project Term

May 1, 2019 – August 31, 2019, full time work

#### Award Amount

A salary of \$15,000.00 will be awarded. No additional benefits or project costs are provided.

#### Eligibility

- Self-identified FNMI student enrolled full-time in a Masters or PhD degree program at a post-secondary academic institution in Alberta, or who has completed graduate training in the past 3 years.
- Willingness to participate in AIM-HI Network activities during the tenure of their award.
