





TRADITIONAL LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

The University of Calgary, located in the heart of Southern Alberta, both acknowledges and pays tribute to the traditional territories of the peoples of Treaty 7, which include the Blackfoot Confederacy (comprised of the Siksika, the Piikani, and the Kainai First Nations), the Tsuut'ina First Nation, and the Stoney Nakoda (including Chiniki, Bears paw, and Goodstoney First Nations). The City of Calgary is also home to the Métis Nation of Alberta, Region 3 (districts 5 and 6). On this land and in this place, we strive to learn together, walk together, and grow together "in a good way."

The University of Calgary's Indigenous Strategy, *ii' taa'poh'to'p*, guides our parallel journey on our path towards transformative reconciliation. The cultural model for UCalgary's Indigenous Strategy, represented above, tells the story of the strategy from a unique symbolic perspective. The cultural model was designed and transferred to the Indigenous Strategy by Traditional Knowledge Keeper and ceremonial Elder, Reg Crowshoe. The Métis sash is a symbol of Métis culture, heritage, and identity.

Ceremonial Traditions

The University of Calgary Honour Song

The Honour Song was gifted to the University of Calgary by Stoney Nakoda Bearspaw First Nation Elder Rod Hunter in 2018 as part of the university's Indigenous Strategy, *ii' taa'poh'to'p*. The UCalgary Honour Song is in the traditional Stoney Nakoda style. Elder Hunter states that most of his songs come to him in his dreams. It is meant to highlight a spiritual connection to all of creation/Creator and bring honour, respect and tribute to a person, ceremony or an event.

You are invited to join in and sing along as the Honour Song is performed.

Coat of Arms

Granted to the university in 1966, the formal coat of arms incorporates the university colours of red and gold. Featured in the top section of the shield is the wild rose of Alberta, flanked by two books that signify learning. Separating the sections is an arch, symbolic of the Chinook arch. The crossed staves and black bull's head are reminiscent of the MacLeod family crest, in recognition of Lieutenant Colonel James F. MacLeod, who is credited with naming Calgary after Calgary Bay on the Isle of Mull in Western Scotland. Under the shield is the escrol bearing our Gaelic motto: *mo shùile togam suas*, which translates to 'I will lift up my eyes.'

Tartan

The University of Calgary's tartan design was created by James Odell, BEd'76, BFA'83 and was officially recognized by the Scottish Tartans Society in 2001.

Mace

Our mace is representative of the authority that rests with the Crown. At the university, the authority of the Crown for the granting of degrees is vested in the Chancellor. The mace bearer brandishes the mace to signify the arrival and departure of the Chancellor. The mace is placed in front of the Chancellor for the duration of the ceremony.

The University of Calgary mace was a gift from Chancellor Emerita Dr. Muriel Kovitz and Dr. David Kovitz, and was used for the first time at the November 1979 Convocation ceremony.

Mace Table

In 1991, a white oak table made by Calgary craftsman John Morel was given to the University of Calgary by Chancellor Emeritus Dr. James Palmer and Mrs. Barbara Palmer to hold our ceremonial mace.



GRADUAND OR GRADUATE? WHAT IS THE DIFFERENCE?

Throughout this program, we use the words graduand and graduate. A graduand is someone who is about to graduate. A graduate is someone who has already done so. Today our students will begin the convocation ceremony as graduands and conclude it as graduates. We are so proud of them all!

Honouring Exceptional Individuals

Honorary Degrees

The honorary degree is the University of Calgary's highest academic honour and is bestowed upon individuals whose notable achievements and community service merit recognition. Honorary degree recipients provide inspiration and leadership to the graduating class, the university and the community.

The Order of the University of Calgary

The Order of the University of Calgary honours individuals who have made distinguished and exemplary contributions to the university above and beyond the requirements of their position. The award may be conferred upon any current or former member of the university community; students, faculty, staff, alumni and volunteers are all eligible.

Distinguished Graduate

Graduands are invited to take the Graduates' Pledge, stating their commitment as alumni to learning, community and representing the university. Leading the pledge is a distinguished graduate — a member of the University of Calgary family noted for their success in living up to our principles.

Degrees Granted

Types of Degrees

The University of Calgary grants bachelor, master and doctoral degrees. A bachelor's degree is an undergraduate degree that typically takes four to five years to complete. A master's degree is a graduate level degree requiring advanced knowledge or training in a particular field of study. A doctoral degree is the highest level of study, where a student completes a dissertation under the supervision of a professor. The focus is on conducting original research in a specialized subject.

Undergraduate Degrees with Honours

Degrees with Honours are awarded in two classes — Honours, and First Class Honours — to students in the faculties of Arts, Haskayne School of Business, Kinesiology, Cumming School of Medicine, and Science. These degrees follow a concentrated course of study in a specialized field. First Class Honours is awarded to students who have obtained a distinctive grade point average as defined by their faculty.

Undergraduate Degrees with Distinction

At the discretion of a faculty, the notation "With Distinction" is inscribed on the permanent record and degree parchment of graduates (except those with an Honours or graduate degree) who have obtained a distinctive grade point average as defined by the faculty.



HONORARY DEGREE

Sara Quin

Acclaimed indie-pop artist, best-selling author and champion of gender, racial, and social justice

Sara Quin, part of the pop-indie band Tegan and Sara, grew up alongside her twin sister Tegan. Sara was a keen reader and writer from her early years, often crafting stories on the family computer. During her time at Crescent Heights High School, the twins formed their first band, Plunk. Sara hand drew the artwork for their first demo, "So Who's in Your Band." The next day, she sold a dozen tapes at school, launching their first merchandise company.

Under Sara's guidance, Tegan and Sara produced a series of indie rock albums beginning in 2002 that would change the course of both their lives.

Over the years, Sara and Tegan have shared stages with renowned artists like Taylor Swift, Katy Perry, Paramore, and Neil Young. They have also performed on some of the world's biggest stages, including Coachella, Lollapalooza, and the Academy Awards.

In 2016, Sara and her sister founded the Tegan and Sara Foundation, aimed at improving the lives of LGBTQ+ women and girls. This initiative upholds their commitment to feminism and racial, social, and gender justice. In 2018, both sisters received a Governor General's Performing Arts Award and the New York Civil Liberties Union Award.

Sara continues to record music and write books with Tegan, their most recent work being "Junior High," a graphic novel created in collaboration with award-winning illustrator Tillie Walden and premiere publisher FSG.

HONORARY DEGREE

Tegan Quin

Award-winning singer-songwriter, best-selling author and LGBTQ+ advocate

Tegan Quin, one half of the celebrated pop-indie duo Tegan and Sara, grew up in northeast Calgary. Initially showing prowess in science and math, Tegan's true passion emerged in junior high when she gravitated towards music and literature. Alongside her twin sister, Sara, Tegan began secretly composing songs on their stepdad's acoustic guitar and recording them for a school project. This project transformed into a demo tape, marking the beginning of her and Sara's illustrious music career.

After high school, Tegan, together with Sara, signed to Neil Young's Vapor Records and toured the globe as an indie rock duo. The partnership has sold over a million records, released ten studio albums, and garnered various Grammy, GLAAD, Polaris, and Juno nominations and awards. Notable among their achievements is their seventh studio album, "Heartthrob," featuring the hit "Closer." Their songs have been featured in TV shows like "Glee," "Grey's Anatomy," "Girls," and "Heartstopper."

In 2016, Tegan, together with Sara, founded the Tegan and Sara Foundation. This initiative, rooted in the sisters' commitment to feminism and social justice, aims to improve the lives of LGBTQ+ women and girls.

Tegan has expanded her creative pursuits to include writing, evidenced by the New York Times bestseller "High School," a memoir she co-authored with Sara about growing up in Calgary in the 90s, which has been adapted into an Amazon TV series.
