Travelling to Canada

Travelling to Canada and quarantine requirements

Travel restrictions are still in place; however, Canada is allowing international students who have a valid study permit or study permit approval letter to enter.

Please time your arrival to Canada no earlier than a month prior to the commencement of the fall term on **August 30, 2021.** If you need to come sooner or if

you have any immigration related questions, please contact our Immigration Advisors at issimmigration@ucalgary.ca to get their guidance.

Once you have confirmed your travel plans, you will need to share your arrival information with UCalgary. Learn how to do this here.

Fully Vaccinated Travellers

Effective **July 5, 2021**, fully-vaccinated travellers who are eligible to enter Canada (including international students with a valid study permit or study permit approval letter) may be exempt from the 14-day quarantine (including the 3-day hotel stay) and COVID-19 testing on day 8 of quarantine.

Fully-vaccinated travellers must have digital or paper proof of an approved COVID-19 vaccination (in English, French, or certified translation), complete pre-departure testing and testing upon arrival in Canada, be asymptomatic while travelling, prepare and submit a quarantine plan, and follow all public health measures currently in place. If you intend to live in UCalgary residence, you must also follow any current quarantine and resident health measures. For more details, please visit the Residence Services website.

Travelling from India

The Government of Canada has extended the suspension of flights flying directly from India to Canada until **July 21, 2021**. If you are travelling to Canada from India through a connecting country, you will be required to obtain a COVID-19 predeparture test from the connecting country before continuing your trip to Canada.

Medical insurance

You must plan for your medical insurance and needs before you travel. Consider:

- What documents should you travel with (e.g. vaccination and health records)?
- Do you have travel medical insurance for your trip and until you have active coverage through the Alberta Health Care Insurance Plan (AHCIP) and the Students' Union (SU)/Graduate Students' Union (GSA), if eligible?
- Are you required to quarantine outside Alberta, in another province—and do you have medical insurance during this time?
- How to apply for the AHCIP after any required quarantine period?
- When does your SU or GSA coverage start?
